Next, you will analyse the film's themes and characterizations before finally sharing your own opinion about the movie.

Learning goals: By completing the tasks, you will become better at:

- Understanding how words can have multiple meanings.
- Dividing a film into parts and analysing those parts to find the plot.
- Identifying different themes and talking about them.
- Describing the main characters.
- Giving your own opinion.
- Using lighting and different settings when recording scenes.

Before watching the film:

- You are going to watch a film called *Scrapper* in English (*Georgies verden*). What does the word *scrapper* mean? Look it up.

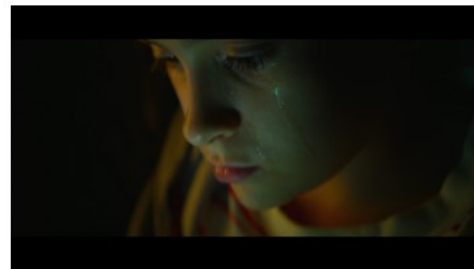
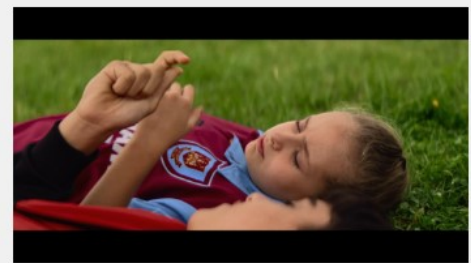
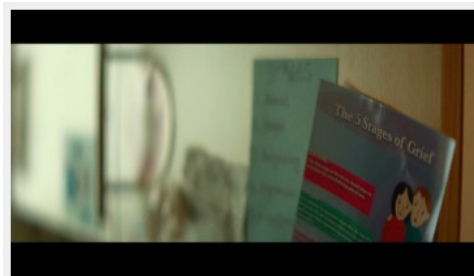
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After watching the film:**Plot**

Describe her dad or Ali.

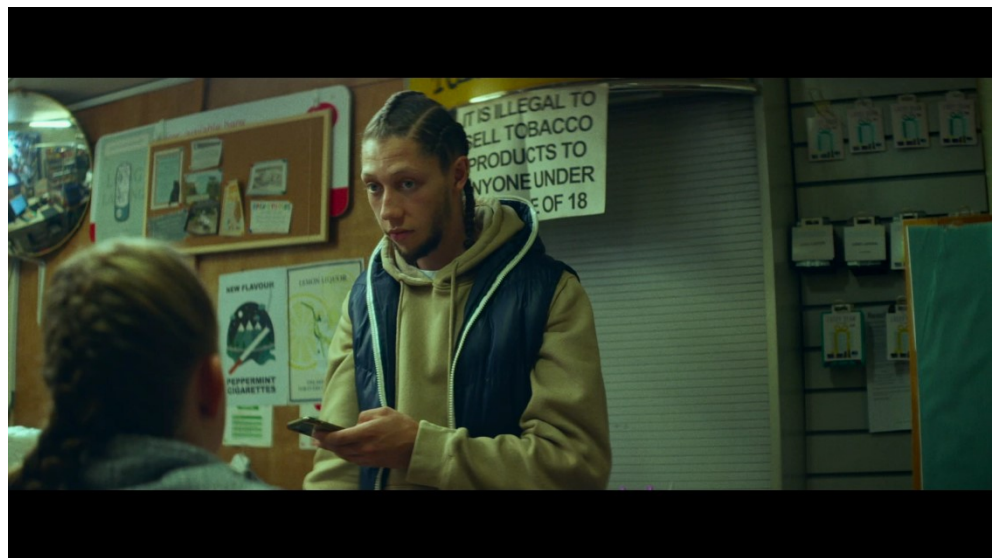
- Describe his appearance.

- What do you believe to be the message of the film?

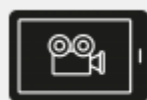
**FILMØVELSE**

She asks the shop keeper to record some lines, which she then uses later during a phone call from a social worker. Invent a similar scene in which Georgie receives a phone call like this.

- Write a short script for the scene.
- Make recordings of the responses on your phone.
- Record the scene.
 - Think of the setting (where the phone call is taking place).
 - Think of the lighting (to set the mood).
